New and unusual species dominate list

## New Rules for Shipment of Seeds

I can no longer guarantee that seed orders mailed in an ordinary envelope will be hand-cancelled. *Begonia* seeds are fragile, and even a small amount of pressure can crack or crush. No germination will occur if that happens. Many of the varieties take months to produce and are very difficult to obtain. Since I have kept seed prices to pre-inflation levels, I feel justified in refusing to fill orders unless they include 40¢ over the seed price total. This 40¢ allows for both postage and padded package. If ordering more than 12 packets, please add 50¢ over the seed price total. Thank You.

- M-A 1—*B. U104*: Rhizomatous *Begonia* collected near Santa Rosa, Costa Rica. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 2—*B. plebeja*: Upright rhizomatous with dark green 5-10 inch ovate leaves; margins ciliate with small lobes at nerve-endings. 3/4-inch white flowers in large cymes in early spring. Seed collected near Madden Dam, Republic of Panama . . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 3—*B. pringlei*: Small felted, slightly lobed rhizomatous species from Mexico, blooming white in fall with a dormant period after. Often called "rock-garden begonia". See picture: *Begonian*, Apr. 1970, p. 82 . . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 4—*B. hatacoa*: syn. *rubro-venia*: Picturesque stemmed and branched species with underground rhizome. The spear-shaped leaves and red-veined flower tepals all add up to an unusual begonia. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 5—*B. versicolor*: Species from China and most colorful for terrarium culture. Variegated leaves, pink flowers and red-plush hairs. Allow 4-6 weeks for germination. One packet per customer. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 6—*B. chlorosticta*: This most unusual shrub-like species was grown for years as "species ex Kew", and was introduced to culture in this country by the late 'Mac' MacIntyre who provided the cover picture, *Beg.* Jan. 1973. From Sarawak, it needs terrarium culture. One packet per customer. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 7—*B. ebolowensis*: A climbing species from South Africa, pictured on page 124, May, 1979 *Beg.* with narrow leaves and wing-less ovaries on female flowers. Keep in closed container until good size before hardening off. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 8—*B. U105*: Small-leaved, shrub-like species with large clusters of white flowers which grows well in baskets. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 9—*B. U106*: Rhizomatous species, collected near road from Panama City to Colon, Republic of Panama. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 10—*B. U107*: Rhizomatous species collected same area as above. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 11—*B. U108*: Large-leaved rhizomatous species collected in same areas as above. . . . . per pkt 1.00
- M-A 12—*B. cathayana*: A rare and beautiful species from China with large, velvet leaves zoned in red and green and decorated with soft purple-red hairs. Orange flowers. This species is rare because culture requirements are exacting — high humidity, constant temperature, low light. See *Beg.* Oct. 1969 for culture tips from Elda Haring. - M-A 13—*B. setosa*: Shrub-like species with small rounded leaves. In appearance, looks like a very hairy *fischeri*. See "Give up? Never!" p. 105, *Beg.* July-Aug. 1983. . . . . per pkt .50
